

West Midlands UK Mega 2022

Camping Terms & Conditions

Each Pitch can contain no more than 1 main unit (Caravan/Motorhome/Tent) and 1 pup tent (maximum 2x2 metres and must be for sleeping only).

Pitches will be 10x10 metres. We reserve the right to change pitch size to suit the needs of the Mega and site conditions as and when required.

Gazebo/Awnings are permitted but must be contained within your own pitch.

Parking for one vehicle, in addition to your camping unit, is permitted per pitch. Additional vehicles and trailers must be parked in the designated parking areas as directed. A short period of time to unload/load your vehicles on arrival/departure is allowed after which vehicle and any trailers should be removed to the car park.

When making your booking you must let the Mega team know your unit type and size if greater than 7metres long. All your equipment must remain inside your pitch. You must leave a 'safety border' around your pitch as a fire break.

Visitors must adhere to all signs and instructions during the time at the Event site.

Electric Hook-Up is for the intended pitch only no splitters are to be used. Please follow directions as to which socket to use for your allocated pitch.

No Electric vehicles to be charged using the electric hook-ups.

Barbecues are permitted but must be raised off ground and attended by an adult at all times. No open fires, raised fires or fire pits allowed.

No refunds/discounts for inclement weather, late arrivals or early departures. If you need to cancel or amend your booking, please give as much notice as possible so that someone else has the chance to book.

Refunds will not be issued if cancellation is made after 30th June 2022.

All pitch bookings must have at least 1 party member that is 18yrs or over on 1st August 2022. Anyone under the age of 18yrs remains the responsibility of their parent/guardian or nominated carer.

You must inform us of any changes to bookings (including, but not limited to, unit type, occupancy and dates) this should be in writing to the Mega Team as as possible, quoting your original order number.

Pets are required to be on a lead at all times, when outside of your unit or within the camping area including the vicinity of the Event hall. This is the requirement of the landowner. You must clear up after your pet(s).

Quiet hours must be respected between 11.30pm and 7.30am. Antisocial behaviour will not be tolerated.

The Mega team reverses the right to deny or terminate the stay of those guests whose behaviour is deemed unsuitable.

Speed limits must be adhered to at all times.

No arrivals to be accepted before 1pm on Monday 1st August 2022. If you arrive before this time you will be turned away and be asked to park and wait off site.

All pitches to be vacated 12 noon on Monday 8th August 2022 and take all your rubbish to the designated area or home.

Chemical toilet waste MUST be disposed off at the designated Elsan point, anyone found using other facilities will be asked to leave.

The Event site is a functioning Racecourse, visitors must not go inside the course itself only use the designated walkways.

The Mega committee takes no responsibility for any personal possessions, property or equipment brought onto the site.

Any lost property not claimed will be disposed of 28days after the official end of the event.

In the event of any discrepancy, the decision of the chair of the committee is final.

Failure to adhere to these terms and conditions may result in you being asked to vacate the site. No refunds will be offered in these circumstances.

We reserve the right to alter these terms and conditions; All changes will be notified to anyone with an active booking in advance of the event.
